



## Animal Control Spay/Neuter

### RI Veterinary Medical Association – Low Income Program

The Rhode Island Veterinary Medical Association has developed a special program to help low-income pet owners afford the cost of spaying or neutering their pets. Through this program, eligible pet owners can receive discounts on spay or neuter surgery at participating veterinary hospitals and clinics throughout Rhode Island and nearby Massachusetts. Please follow these important guidelines:

- You must be at least 18 years of age
- You must complete a separate application for each animal you wish to have spayed or neutered.
- You will be asked to provide a copy of your most recent pay stub or assistance documentation (SSDI, SSI, AFDC, Unemployment information, etc.)
- Pay stubs from all adults in household with jobs must be attached to the application.
