Trash and Recycling

Planning to Move out of Cumberland

We understand it is a busy time but by following these guidelines, it should help make your move stress free.

Town trash limits will apply. In addition to your trash cart, only one bulky item (an item that is permitted in the trash) will be picked up per week

Plan ahead especially if you have many items to dispose. Consider donating any item that is still usable.

Not all items can go in the trash collection. Mattresses, box springs, construction items, hazardous items, TVs, computer waste, appliances are some items we cannot collect with the weekly trash. If unsure, please ask. We are happy to explain how to properly dispose unaccepted items.

Hazardous waste cannot be collected as trash or recycling. Ask about state organized household hazardous waste collections - they're free and convenient.

Don't leave items out at the curb. Trash and recycling should only be placed out no earlier than 6 pm the night prior to your collection day. The town will sticker items placed in error and are not collected curbside. Please make sure to remove off the road. We want to keep our street clear and safe for all to enjoy our community.

Leave the Trash and Recycle Cart at your property. The town issued carts, STAY at the property for the new owner, and we have a serial number registered for each house. Replacements are very expensive. This cost is \$65 to \$85 for a new cart.

Call with any questions. We are here to help! Proper sorting does get confusing. A quick call to our Recycling office (728-2400 x 155) can make sure you do not come home to the frustration of items left after collection day.

Moving to Cumberland

Welcome to Cumberland. We hope your move in to our town goes smoothly.

Make sure you have a brown Trash Cart and blue Recycle cart. During your final walk through, new residents should check that the carts have been left on the property. Carts are issued by the Town and are required to stay with the property, even when ownership changes.

Recycle all your boxes. Just flatten and place in cart. Too many for the cart? Drop off is available at RIRRC in Johnston RI.
