Parks

Diamond Hill Park, 4097 Diamond Hill Road, Cumberland, RI.

Picnic Areas, Outdoor Stage, Hiking Trails, Ski Lodge Building, Multi-purpose Fields, Ball Fields. For Passive and Active Recreational Activities. 152 acres.

The Monastery, 1464 Diamond Hill Road, Cumberland, RI.

Picnic Areas, Walking/Jogging Trails, Playground, Veteran's Memorial, Nine Men's Misery Monument, Restrooms. Library and Senior Center located on the grounds. 480+ acres of open space.

Fanning Wilderness Area, Valley Falls, Cumberland, RI.

Wilderness/Open Space area that is part of the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor. 40 Acres.

Valley Falls Heritage Park, 45 Broad Street (across from Town Hall), Cumberland, RI.

2.52 acre historical site which has a picnic area and educational interpretive panels. This is also part of the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor.

Moran Family Park, Located on Mendon Road between Beamis Ave and Farm Drive, Cumberland, RI.

Park with a passive recreation area and stone wall for seating. 0.5 acres.

Blackstone Memorial Park, Located at the corner of Blackstone Street and Broad Street, Cumberland, RI.

Historic park in honor of William Blackstone, founder of Boston and the first white settler in Rhode Island. 0.25 acres.
