**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF
STATE OF MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY**

April 2, 2020

WHEREAS: On March 16, 2020, I, Jeffrey J. Mutter, issued a Declaration of State of Municipal Emergency; and

WHEREAS: The Town of Cumberland continues to coordinate a comprehensive response to ever-changing events and circumstances on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS: containing the community spread of the COVID-19 virus is of critical importance to the long-term health and safety of our residents, town employees, and others within our community; and

WHEREAS: Rhode Island General Laws §§ 30-15-12(b) and 30-15-9(e)(13) permit the Mayor to “do all other things necessary to effectively cope with disasters in the Town not inconsistent with other provisions of law.”

NOW THEREFORE, I, JEFFREY J. MUTTER, pursuant to the powers vested in the Mayor by the Rhode Island General Laws and the Cumberland Town Charter, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. All Town offices are closed to the public. The public shall contact Town employees by email or telephone to coordinate any Town business. Specifically, this includes the Town Hall, Water Department, Highway Department, Senior Services, Library and the Office of Children, Youth and Learning.
2. The Tucker Field Complex is closed to the public.

This Declaration is effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until April 15, 2020 unless renewed, modified or terminated by subsequent Declaration.
