



**EO-20-03**

**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF  
STATE OF MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY**

**April 15, 2020**

**WHEREAS:** On March 16, 2020, I, Jeffrey J. Mutter, issued a Declaration of State of Municipal Emergency (EO-20-01), which was ratified by the Town Council on April 6, 2020; and

**WHEREAS:** On April 2, 2020, I issued a supplemental declaration (EO-20-02), which was ratified by the Town Council on April 6, 2020; and

**WHEREAS:** Governor Raimondo recently issued Executive Order 20-24, which requires that employees and customers of “customer/client-facing businesses” shall wear cloth face coverings “in entry, exit and common areas”; and

**WHEREAS:** The Town of Cumberland continues to coordinate a comprehensive response to ever-changing events and circumstances on a daily basis; and


**WHEREAS:** containing the community spread of the COVID-19 virus is of critical importance to the long-term health and safety of our residents and others within our community; and

**WHEREAS:** Rhode Island General Laws §§ 30-15-12(b) and 30-15-9(e)(13) permit the Mayor to “do all other things necessary to effectively cope with disasters in the Town not inconsistent with other provisions of law.”

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JEFFREY J. MUTTER,** pursuant to the powers vested in the Mayor by the Rhode Island General Laws and the Cumberland Town Charter, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. To further protect patrons of Cumberland’s parks and recreational areas, all patrons of outdoor parks and recreational areas in Cumberland shall wear cloth face coverings at all times while on park properties and recreational areas.
2. The Tucker Field Complex continues to be closed to the public.

This Declaration is effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until May 20, 2020 unless renewed, modified or terminated by subsequent Declaration.
