**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF
STATE OF MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY**

September 25, 2020

WHEREAS: I, Jeffrey J. Mutter, issued a Declaration of State of Municipal Emergency (EO-20-01), which was ratified by the Town Council on April 6, 2020; and

WHEREAS: Thereafter, I issued supplemental orders EO-20-02, -03, -04, and -05, which were ratified by the Town Council, as well as EO-20-06, 07 (relating to a curfew); and

WHEREAS: In light of the ever-changing events and circumstances, and considering that the State of Rhode Island is now in Phase III of the Reopening RI Plan, I intend to provide the ability to make our businesses as successful as possible while continuing to commit to keeping our community healthy and safe; and

WHEREAS: Rhode Island General Laws §§ 30-15-12(b) and 30-15-9(e)(13) permit the Mayor to “do all other things necessary to effectively cope with disasters in the Town not inconsistent with other provisions of law.”

NOW THEREFORE, I, JEFFREY J. MUTTER, pursuant to the powers vested in the Mayor by the Rhode Island General Laws and the Cumberland Town Charter, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. For those businesses that currently hold an entertainment license, indoor entertainment is permitted where “Phase III Guidelines for Restaurants,” as updated, at reopeningri.com is followed. In the event the State reverts back to Phase II, this Executive Order shall terminate simultaneously.
2. Outdoor entertainment, as provided for by EO-20-05-A is preferred and encouraged to promote social distancing.

This Declaration is effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect unless renewed, modified or terminated by subsequent Declaration.
