How to register

- Payments are non-refundable so please check your schedule before registering
- OCYL accepts Cash, Check and Credit Cards
- Amount due must be paid upon registration. School Year Literacy/Number Sense registrations may be paid with a non-refundable 10% deposit and automated credit card payments
- Use a credit card or electronic check when registering online through our point of sale program: ACTIVE Network
- Cash or check payments require in-person registration during regular business hours, 8:30-4:30, Monday-Friday
- Provide name, relationship & phone number for all adults & emergency contacts authorized to pick up your child
- Complete supplemental forms including: photo waiver and refund policy
- Cumberland rates are subject to proof of residency
- Waitlisted students do not pay until offered a seat
- Cumberland residents pay a reduced rate due to the ongoing generous support of the Town of Cumberland. Rates are subject to proof of residency

Financial Assistance for Cumberland Residents (*only*)

Register and pay the minimum of 10% (or otherwise noted amount) when registering. Additional payment, based on our sliding scale may be necessary after documentation is approved (see below).

- EMAIL/MAIL/FAX a current free/reduced lunch approval letter (FRL), WIC or SNAP benefits
- Or, you may apply to our “Sliding Scale.” Answer the following during registration:
 - 1) State Annual Gross Income (before any withholdings) which includes:
Wages, Salaries, Tips, Net Income from any self-employment or business, unemployment compensation, Alimony, Child Support, Retirement Income, Investment Income, Pension Income, Rental Income, Other taxable income such as prizes, awards, and gambling winnings, and Social Security payments, including disability payments but not Supplemental Security Income (SSI).
 - 2) State number of children under 18 and the number of adults living in the home.
 - 3) Submit proof of all adult household income including the most recent 4 weeks of paystubs/benefits or the most recent tax return. Mail or email: main.ocyl@gmail.com or fax to (401)721-5852
- If you are approved for the sliding scale, an email will be sent indicating the amount due if you qualify. Your registration will be adjusted to reflect the cost. Any amount due must be paid within 5 days of notification.
