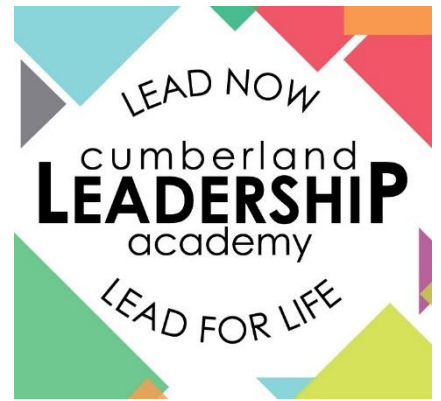


CUMBERLAND LEADERSHIP ACADEMY
