Job Ad: Part-time seasonal teacher/instructor positions in STEAM

Position Summary

We're looking for creative, enthusiastic teachers/instructors who can facilitate their excitement of the STEAM art and/or engineering "design processes" with youth in Cumberland, Rhode Island.

Share your passion for creating and "making": collaborate with the OCYL K-12 Program Coordinator to create and/or implement programs and camps to serve Grades K-9 through our STEAMshop initiative. These programs focus on the students' experiences and the processes, more than the final project.

The teacher will be responsible for planning, set-up, and implementation, creating a safe and nurturing environment and communicating positively with students and families. Opportunities available for Summer 2021 and potential for School Year 2021-22. Programs typically meet 1x per week for 8 weeks afterschool each season, for multiple age levels or as one-week camps in the summer. Status is as a *part-time seasonal* employee of the Town of Cumberland.

Requirements

Afterschool and/or or school day teaching experience in a professional environment is required. Qualified candidates should have a background in a STEAM field, be a self-motivated, organized, responsible, and love working with youth. All applicants must have legal authorization to work in the United States and must submit an approved Background Check/Fingerprinting and must have reliable transportation.

Responsibilities include:

- Work with Program Coordinator to ensure implementation plans align with STEAMshop mission
- Prep materials for each session, set up and clean up
- Get to know students and take attendance each day
- Ensure activities are hands on and highly engaging
- Follow all COVID prevention and after-school safely protocols
